

# Arbors' COVID Stage Guidance

This document outlines the stages and factors related to Arbors' response to COVID-19 (subject to regulatory requirements). Risk escalation can be related to local area OR community factors. Remember, this is in place to protect all staff and **residents- the most vulnerable population**. Stay Safe!

Remember the 3 W's: Wear your mask, Wash your hands, Watch your distance!

<b>Resident Activities</b>	Groups of 20 or fewer residents gathering in community  Residents are strongly discouraged from off-campus public gathering spaces, including grocery stores, religious services not offering social distanced services, theaters, malls, etc.	Groups of 5 or fewer residents gathering in community  External activities visitors prohibited (yoga instructor, lecturers, etc)  Follow additional COVID Warning steps about outings	Groups of residents prohibited  Common areas closed  Follow additional Moderate Exposure risk steps  Off campus trips: isolation precautions based on risk assessment	Residents advised to remain in apartments with exception of medical appointments and emergencies
<b>Dining</b>	Communal dining limited to 50% capacity. Room service available	Communal dining capacity limited to state guidelines  Tablemates unchanged until risk level is reduced (residents may opt for room service)	Room service only	Room service only with limited menu
<b>Visitors</b> Note: visitors coming from a travel advisory location may not enter Arbors until in Connecticut for 14 days.	Essential vendors that provide operationally critical services (pharmacy, mail, food, supplies, maintenance, healthcare providers including caregivers & physical therapy)  Family/friend visits limited to 2 adult members at a time, and restricted to resident apartment or designated outdoor areas	Visitors discouraged from non-essential visits. Outside visits or chat room visits available (2 adult visitors at once). Visitors encouraged to participate in COVID testing within 72 hours of visiting  External activities visitors prohibited (yoga instructor, lecturers, etc)  Sales tours limited to 3 scheduled visitors at a time, limited touring	Essential vendors and care providers only  No visitors (exceptions for imminent end-of-life situations). Outside visits or chat room visits only (2 adult visitors at once)  Virtual sales tours only	Essential vendors and care providers only  No visitors (exceptions for imminent end-of-life situations)  Virtual sales tours only
