



Procedures for Visitors effective 4/12/21

Visitors must provide proof of negative COVID status, COVID recovered status, or proof of complete vaccination.

These guidelines are subject to change, based on community health indicators.

All visitors shall show vaccination, COVID-negative or cured status

Visitors must show proof of one of these:

- 1) Proof of vaccination (second dose administered at least 2 weeks ago) or;
- 2) Negative COVID PCR test. Test must be conducted within 7 days of the visit to Arbors.

Paper copies or copies viewed on mobile devices are accepted.

Visitors who have recovered from COVID and can evidence recovery within the last 90 days are permitted. Recovery after 90 days of positive will require proof of testing or vaccination.

Persons who feel ill or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 over the last 14 days shall not visit Arbors.

No Use of Interior Common Areas

Visitors must remain in resident apartments. The use of common areas (including common area bathrooms) is not permitted.

Follow 6 ft and mask guidelines

Masks are required in all common areas at all times.

Masks should be worn in the apartment if their visitor is not vaccinated and multiple households are visiting at the same time or if visitor is unvaccinated and considered at a high risk of illness. Eating or drinking is permitted if all participants are vaccinated, otherwise it should be avoided.

Miscellaneous

Out of state visitors are permitted to visit onsite (if vaccinated or can show a negative COVID result), but should review the CDC travel guidelines prior to arrival.

Visitors should use hand sanitizer upon arrival/departure & wash hands when entering the apartment.
