
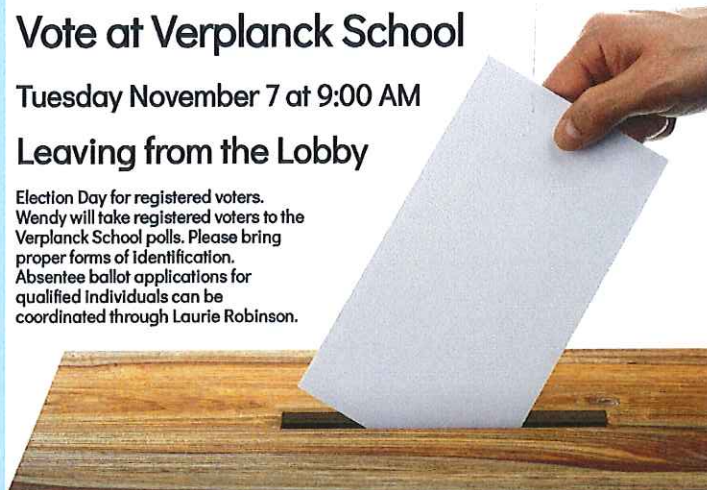

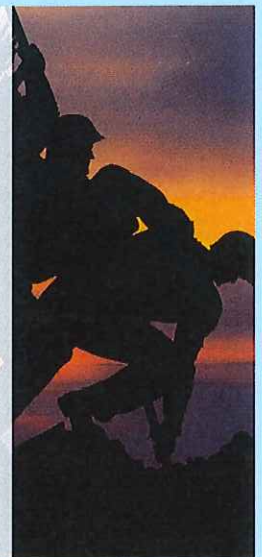
Lisa Franco will discuss her beautiful book
